



## Project: BACK-TO-SCHOOL NOTEBOOK

### Materials:

Quantity	Material
	dotty alphabet stickers
1	9" x 12" blue foam sheet
1	recycled cereal box
8	heart stickers
1	22" long ribbon
2	purple Fuzzy Stix™
1	silver Tinsel Stix™
2	8 mm purple rhinestones
1	8 mm green rhinestone
1	hole puncher
	craft foam glue
	5" x 8" index cards

### Instructions:

- 1) Cut cereal box into two 9" x 6" rectangles for cover and back cover. Cut foam sheet in half.
- 2) Glue one foam sheet to colored side of back.
- 3) On back cover, draw pencil line 1 1/2" on one short end. Fold on this line to make opening notebook easier.
- 4) On second piece of foam, draw 1 1/2" on short end and cut.
- 5) Glue both pieces of foam to front cover.
- 6) Punch holes on end flap of cover 2" from top and bottom. Trace holes onto index cards and back cover, then punch.
- 7) Sandwich index cards between covers. Thread ribbon through both holes in cover, index cards and back cover. Tie in front.
- 8) Stick name stickers to front.
- 9) Coil Fuzzy Stix™ around pencil and glue to front cover as bodies. Stick hearts near bodies as wings.

### **Instructions:**

- 10) Cut Tinsel Stix™ in half. Fold each piece in half and roll ends. Glue to bodies as antennae.
- 11) Glue purple rhinestones to wings and green rhinestone to name.
