

Project: BAT AND SPIDER TREAT BOXES



Materials:

Quantity	Material
2	1/2" pint school milk containers
1	8 1/2" x 11" black foam sheet
4	3/4" circle foam stickers, 2 orange and 2 purple
1	black Fuzzy Stix™
1	purple Fuzzy Stix™
1	12 mm Googly Eyes™
12	beads, 4 green, 4 purple and 4 orange
	purple and green paper
	decorative-edged scissors
	hole puncher
	craft foam glue

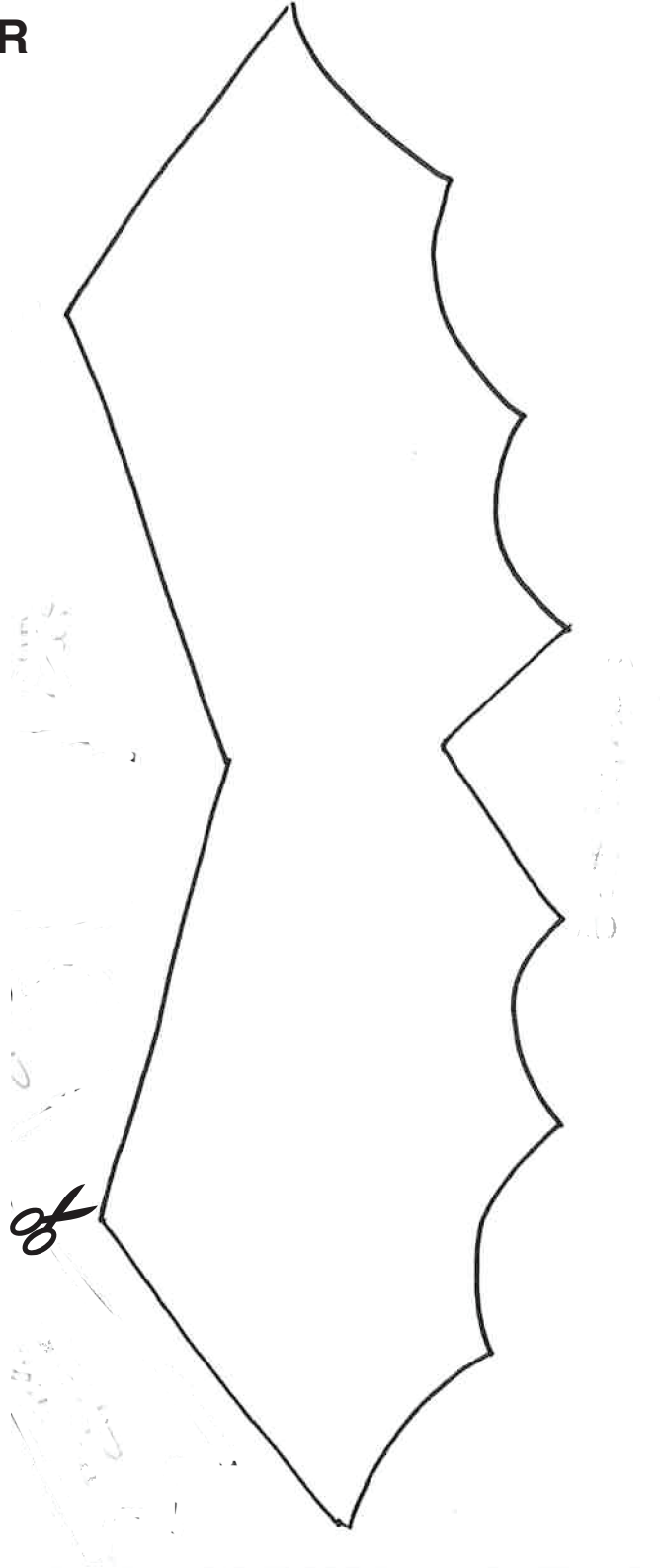
Instructions:

- 1) Cut paper to fit around containers. Glue to containers.
- 2) BAT: Using template, trace wing and ear patterns onto black foam and cut out. Glue wings to back of box and ears to inside front.
- 3) SPIDER: Cut eight strips 2 1/2" x 3/4" from black foam. Cut long edges using decorative-edged scissors. Glue legs to back of box.
- 4) EYES: Stick orange circle foam stickers to bat face and purple circle foam stickers to spider face. Glue Googly Eyes™ to circles.
- 5) Thread green and purple beads onto ends of purple Fuzzy Stix™ for spider. Then thread purple beads on black Fuzzy Stix™ for bat.
- 6) Punch hole on each side of box. Push Fuzzy Stix™ into holes and twist to secure.
