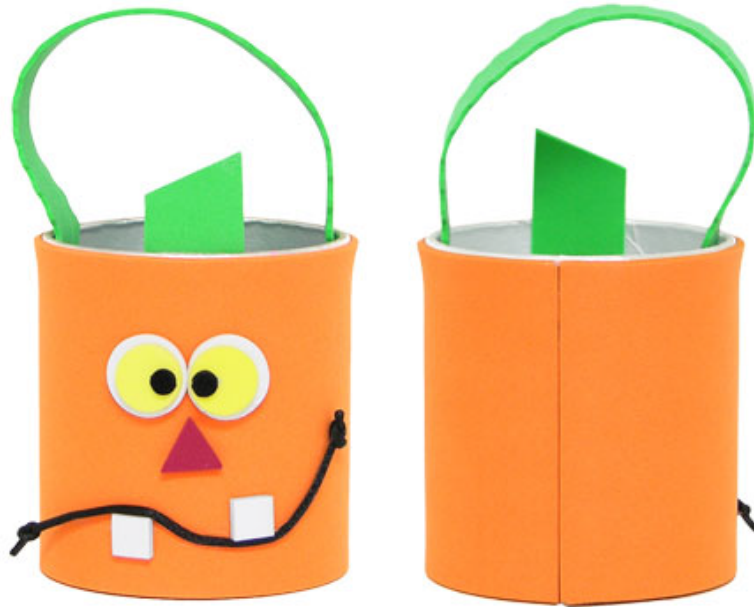




## Project: PUMPKIN TREAT CAN



### Materials:

---

Quantity	Material
	geometric foam stickers
1	recycled 3 1/2" wide can (recommended: Pringles)
2	8 1/2" x 11" foam sheets, 1 orange and 1 green
1	black foam scrap
2	7/8" white foam circle stickers (outer eyes)
2	5/8" yellow foam circle stickers (inner eyes)
2	5/8" red foam triangle (nose)
2	3/8" white foam square (mouth)
1	6" long black cord (mouth)
	craft foam glue
	decorative-edged scissors
	hole puncher
	scissors
	ruler
	pencil

### Instructions:

---

- 1) Cut orange foam to fit around can and glue. TIP: Use clothespin or tape to hold in place until dry.
- 2) Stick white and yellow foam eyes to face. Punch 2 black foam holes and glue to eyes.
- 3) Stick nose to face.
- 4) Knot both ends of mouth cord and glue to face.
- 5) Stick 2 teeth to mouth.
- 6) Cut a 1" x 1 1/2" stem from green foam and cut top edge on angle. Glue to top of pumpkin.
- 7) Cut a 1" wide x 8" long handle from green foam using decorative-edged scissors. Glue ends to inside of pumpkin.
- 8) Fill pumpkin with candy treats!
