



Project: RECYCLED BUMBLEBEE

Materials:

Quantity	Material
1	empty half and half container (32 fl oz Friendly Farms brand recommended)
2	9" x 12" yellow felt sheets
1	9" x 12" black felt sheets
2	15 mm Googly Eyes™
2	Fibre-Craft® eyelashes
1	3/4" red pom
1	3/4" black pom
2	1/2" black poms
2	12" white Shimmer Stix™ (pipe cleaner)
1	12" black Fuzzy Stix™ (pipe cleaner)
1	12" yellow Fuzzy Stix™ (pipe cleaner)
1	Creative Hands® foam glue or low temp glue gun craft glue pencil

Instructions:

- 1) Body: Trace container bottom on 1 sheet of yellow paper. Cut circle out and set aside. Wrap 2nd sheet of yellow felt around container to form bumblebee body, leaving top and bottom uncovered. Cut to fit and glue onto container. Glue yellow felt circle on bottom.
- 2) Stripe: Cut 2" wide strip in black felt sheet to wrap around middle of bumblebee body. Glue on.
- 3) Bee face: Trace container top on remaining black felt. Cut circle out and set aside. Cut strip of black felt to fit around container neck as bumblebee head. Glue both pieces on to form bee head and face.
- 4) Eyes: Glue on Googly Eyes™ and eyelashes using craft glue. Nose: Glue on red pom. Mouth: Cut 2 1/4" off yellow Fuzzy Stix™ and curve before gluing on below nose. Let dry for half hour.
- 5) Antennae: Cut 6" off yellow Fuzzy Stix™ and glue 1/2" black poms to each end. Bend antennae in middle and glue on behind eyes. Glue 3/4" black pom over it as shown.
- 6) Wings: Take 1 Shimmer Stix™ and form a loop. Repeat with other Shimmer Stix™. Glue to back of bee body as shown.
- 7) Stinger: Coil black Fuzzy Stix™ loosely around pencil. Glue to end of bee body.
